Thank you for your interest in our meat CSA and for supporting sustainable agriculture! Please read the following form carefully.


OUR FARMING PRACTICE

Herondale Farm takes pride in producing 100% grass fed and grass finished beef and lamb as well as pasture raised chicken and pork. We raise healthy and happy animals. We use no hormones or antibiotics. We raise heritage breeds of beef because we're particular about the quality of our meat. British White and Murray Grey beef breeds were selected for their century-old physiologies that allow them to thrive in a grass fed program. Our chickens and pigs enjoy a varied diet combining grass, alfalfa, clover and bugs from the pastures in combination with an organic feed mix. They spend a great deal of their time outside in the fresh air, and are free to roam and graze.

ABOUT OUR CSA

We offer 10, 15 or 20-pound shares, which include a variety of meats (prime cuts, braising and roasting meats, and ground meat and sausages). We meticulously weigh each item out before it is placed in the bags in order to meet the required weights. Because every cut of meat is different, this means that sometimes the cuts included in the shares will vary. Our CSA runs all year long, with the exception of the chicken share, which runs from June to November. We highly recommend that member purchase a slow cooker to make the most out of their share.

THE SHARES



- TIER A Beef steaks, pork chops, lamb chops, leg of lamb, chicken breast, bacon
- TIER B Brisket, london broil, ribs, roasts, shanks, whole chicken, chicken leg & thigh
- TIER C Ground meat, kabobs, sausages, hot dogs, chicken wings

Deliveries

Meat is delivered in freezer bags, packed in coolers and MUST be picked up day of delivery! At pickup, members must leave the freezer bags in the coolers so that we can reuse them the following month. We give each new member a special Herondale Farm bag upon signing up which they can use to take the meat home with them, otherwise members are responsible for bringing their own bag.

Pickups

Members are responsible for showing up at one of the pickup locations listed on the form. Depending on your pickup location, delivery is either the *1st or 2nd Wednesday* of each month. Members must contact their CSA coordinator for any inquiries. Once the shares are delivered to the pick up locations, they are in charge! At the end of pickup, no shares are sent back to us – if you do not pick up your share, it will be donated unless the pick up location has enough freezer space to hold it.

Commitment

We ask that our new members commit to at least three months of shares. Members can pay this initial cost upfront or in installments. If a member wishes to cancel their membership before this initial period has elapsed, we will still charge them for the remaining months. New members must pay a one time \$10 fee to cover the cost of the freezer bags and administration.

Chicken shares

Members must commit to the entire 6- month chicken season (June-November). Members are still charged on a month-to-month basis. If a member wishes to cancel their share before the end of the season, they will be charged the remainder of the balance due for the season. If a member wishes to pay for the season upfront, they will receive \$10 off. Chicken share members are allowed to put their share on hold for ONE month only during the entire 6-month season.

Changes/Cancellations

If you know that you will miss a pick up date, why not ask a friend to pick it up for you?! Otherwise, members are allowed to put their share on hold at any time after the initial 3 month commitment period has elapsed.

If you would like to cancel or change the type of share you receive, please let us know at least 2 weeks before the delivery date.

Options

Members may opt out of ONE type of meat: pork, lamb or chicken. We cannot accommodate opting out of specific types of cuts.

Like a specific kind of steak? Want more bacon? Members receive 10% off any extra a la carte items they wish to add to their share. Please <u>www.herondalefarm.com/csa</u> for a complete price list.

Payments

Members will be charged once a month, the week prior to their delivery date. i.e. A share to be delivered the first week of August will be billed the last week of July. We charge our members directly with the credit card information they provide, using an online sales program.
